### **2023 Colville Tribal Member Ps'quosa Ceremonial and Subsistence Spring Chinook Fishery Regulations, 7-day per Week, 24-hours per Day Fishery Opening (Icicle Creek, Leavenworth, WA)**

*Effective immediately, the 2023 Colville Ps'quosa Spring Chinook Fishery on Icicle Creek will be open to Wenatchi Members of the Colville Confederated Tribes for an expanded fishery of 7-days per week, 24-hours per day.*

*All other provisions of Resolution 2023-264, the 2023 Colville Tribal Member, Ps'quosa Ceremonial and Subsistence Spring Chinook Fishery Regulation, remain in effect.*
