## **In-Season Regulation Change**

2023 Colville Tribal Member Ps'quosa Ceremonial and Subsistence Spring Chinook Fishery Regulations, 7-day per Week, 24-hours per Day Fishery Opening (Icicle Creek, Leavenworth, WA)

Effective immediately, the 2023 Colville Ps'quosa Spring Chinook Fishery on Icicle Creek will be open to Wenatchi Members of the Colville Confederated Tribes for an expanded fishery of 7-days per week, 24-hours per day.

All other provisions of Resolution 2023-264, the 2023 Colville Tribal Member, Ps'quosa Ceremonial and Subsistence Spring Chinook Fishery Regulation, remain in effect.
